died April 18, 1970, at  
Keller Hospital in Fayette;  
was raised on his parents farm  
North of Glasgow; attended  
St. Mary's School to Grade 6;  
worked at home until 1922,  
when he moved with his bride  
to their new home just to the  
East on 100 acres purchased  
from his mother.

by Father Joe Westhues,  
the founding-pastor of the  
parish and John's brother
